All of these will be discussed at the 2024 meeting.

In addition to the White Papers in development, the meeting will cover a wide range of topics including lung cancer screening, diagnosis, and treatment, early-stage COPD, and Artificial Intelligence. The scientific sessions will present original data, followed by extensive discussions and proposals for future studies, documents or needs for technological development. The overall aim of the sessions is to identify how these fields will move in the next years. In addition, limited opportunities are available for industry partner participation in our round table forums with the Fleischner thought leaders on various topics including lung cancer and Artificial Intelligence. - To improve the methods of teaching radiologic diagnosis of chest disease
- To promote closer fellowship among, and exchange of ideas between members of the profession whose major interests lie in the chest
